

# **TENTATIVE MARCHING BAND ITINERARY**

## **Lake Park – Saturday, September 11<sup>th</sup>**

- The call time is 6:45 AM.
- Rehearsal at 7:00 AM. This will be a marching rehearsal with playing. Your instruments will be needed, and pit will play set by set.
